## FEES AND CHARGES INFORMATION 2009

### Term Dates (Students) : 2009

- Term 1: Monday 2 February – Thursday 9 April  
*(Please note Good Friday 10 April 2009, Easter Sunday 12 April 2009,  
Easter Monday 13 April 2009, ANZAC Day Saturday 25 April 2009

- Term 3: Wednesday 22 July – Friday 25 September
- Term 4: Tuesday 13 October – Tuesday 8 December (after Speech Night)

### **REGISTRATION FEE**

In order to register a student to be considered for enrolment, an Application for Admission form must be completed and a fee of \$50 (GST included) paid. This fee is not refundable and is designed to cover administration costs associated with enrolments and interviews. Please note that the acceptance by the School of an Application for Admission Form and the non-refundable processing fee, does not guarantee an interview for enrolment or an offer of enrolment.

### **ENROLMENT FEE**

Confirmation of the enrolment is dependent upon an interview at a time and date to be nominated by the School, and upon the payment of a non-refundable Enrolment Fee.

#### **It is important to note:**

1. An Enrolment Fee will be payable at the time a confirmed placement is accepted for a student entering Frederick Irwin Anglican School. This Fee when paid will be credited to the School Endowment Fund as a contribution towards the existing buildings and educational facilities **and is non-refundable**.

The Enrolment Fee will be payable at the time the first student family member is offered a placement at the School. No further Enrolment Fee will be payable for subsequent student siblings attending concurrently.

The Enrolment Fee will represent 25% of the Annual Tuition Fee for a Year 12 student applicable at the time of placement for students entering in the years from Kindergarten through to and including Year 10.

The Enrolment Fee applicable for families entering students in Year 11 is one half of the applicable Enrolment Fee and for students entering in Year 12 will be one quarter of the applicable Enrolment Fee.

2. The Enrolment Fee is a commitment to the School that the student will take up the position stated in the ***formal Letter of Offer***.
3. The Enrolment Fee will not be refunded after the place has been formally accepted, unless the withdrawal results from the parent receiving an employment transfer interstate or overseas prior to the student attending the School.

### **NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL**

The Principal ***must*** be given ***a full Term's notice in writing*** prior to the withdrawal of a student from the School. In default of such notice a quarter of the Annual Tuition Fee will be charged in lieu of notice.

### **SCHOOL BUILDING FUND**

The School has established a School Building Fund to which parents are encouraged to donate. These funds will be used to maintain and extend the School Facilities in the future.

The Fund is approved by the Australian Taxation Office, and therefore all donations over \$2 are eligible tax deductions. Enquiries should be made to The Bursar.

All Government per capita subsidies are paid directly to the School and have been taken into account in setting the fees.

The above fees include all tuition costs OTHER THAN Textbook hire and/or purchase, Subject Levies, Excursions/Camps, Music Lessons and Voluntary excursions outside normal School hours.

### Primary Levies: Per Year (To be billed in 4 equal instalments)

### Secondary Levies: Per Year (To be billed in 4 equal instalments)

Years 8, 9 & 10	\$422 per year
Years 11 & 12	\$448 per year

### Information Technology Levy: Per Year

Pre-Primary – Year 12	\$100

Some additional charges may apply for special model projects in Woodwork, Metalwork and Art.

All other charges for consumables in Home Economics/Independent Living, Information Technology, Design & Technology, Social Sciences, Science, English, English Literature, Drama, and Photocopying are included in the annual levies.

## Excursions and Camps

The following estimates have been made of the possible additional costs for excursions and camps in 2009. This information is provided to assist families in their budgeting; however, it is *indicative only* and may vary by subject options for each secondary student when finalised in 2009.

(Other elective activities not included are The Instrumental Music Camps for Years 4 –12 \$175, Art Camp \$210, Biology Camp \$105, and Year 4 Zoo Sleepover \$110).

Music Lessons - \$28.00 per half hour lesson.

Where students choose Outdoor Education as an elective subject, additional costs will be incurred due to the nature of the activities.

## GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

GST legislation provides that tuition fees incurred in education courses are GST free, however, there are some activities and expenses that will attract GST. The Term Fee Statements will identify any GST component.

## PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS

Tuition Fees and charges may be paid by Bankcard, Cash, Cheque, Direct Debit, Mastercard, Visacard and BPay. Cheques should be made payable to *Frederick Irwin Anglican School*. For your convenience EFTPOS facilities are available at the School Office to receive payments by mail, telephone or in person.

## OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

A late payment fee of \$55 (GST included) will be charged if payment has not been received within 14 days following the due date and/or alternative payment arrangements have not been made with The Bursar. A student may not be permitted to commence a new Term without the consent in writing of The Principal of the School being first obtained, unless the previous Term's Fees, Levies and Charges are paid in full.

### **FAMILY CONCESSION**

A reduction of 20% of the Tuition Fee is made for each student member of the family concurrently attending the School, other than the eldest.

### **GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE**

Parents are invited to contact The Bursar regarding *Austudy* and the *Additional Assistance and Clothing Allowance Scheme*.

**Austudy:** Provides financial help to students aged 16 years or over, who are studying approved full-time secondary courses, on an income and asset-tested basis.

**Additional Assistance and Clothing Allowance Scheme:** The Education Department of W.A. funds a High School Clothing allowance and an Additional Assistance Scheme.

Parents who hold a Department of Social Security Pensioner Health Benefit and Concession Card, Health Benefits Card or Health Care Card, or Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Health Benefit Card, are eligible to apply.

### **INSURANCE**

It is strongly recommended that parents check their health cover and insurance policies to ensure adequate medical, ambulance, personal property and liability insurance cover is held. The School does not accept responsibility for loss of, or damage to, personal effects and property, or for bodily injury or property damage incurred by students.

### **STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

All students attending this School are covered against accidental injury under a "Student Accident Insurance Plan". Details of benefits and costs are available from The Bursar.

### **STATIONERY, BOOKS & EQUIPMENT**

Booklists are provided prior to the commencement of Term 1. Secondary Lists should be completed and purchases of new books should be made from the various retailers or the School's preferred supplier.

### **LEAVE**

The School does **NOT** grant leave for holidays during Term time. Student absence during Term time can adversely impact on a student's results. Leave for exceptional circumstances can only be agreed following written application to The Principal.

### **PARENTS AND FRIENDS' ASSOCIATION**

Family membership of the P & F Association is automatic.

It is by participation in P & F sponsored activities that parents can fulfil their 20 hour per year voluntary support obligation. This involvement will assist the School to maintain its comparatively low fee status.

A compulsory Fund Raising Levy of \$15 per term per family will be charged by the P & F Association. This levy will be billed on the Term Fee Statements.

### **SCHOOL BUS SERVICES**

Details of all School Bus Services can be obtained from the School Office.

#### **PORT KENNEDY / ROCKINGHAM SERVICE**

The School operates a School Bus Service for students living between Port Kennedy and Rockingham. Access to this service can be obtained by purchasing a Term Pass or Books of Tickets from the School Office.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORMS**

Wearing of the correct School Uniform is compulsory for all students. Uniforms are **ONLY** available from the School Uniform Shop.
